

The June 12th meeting was called to order by Jeff Grady, President.

We could not think of any **old business** to discuss, so we proceeded onto the Heartland Nova Reunion.

Heartland Nova Reunion: Dave has purchased 6 (8-10 pound) pork loins and will purchase 150 buns, baked beans, potato salad, cole slaw, BBQ sauce (Sweet Baby Ray's), water, condiments (ketchup, mustard, onions, dill pickles) and paper plates (enough for 75 people). There are currently 61 pre-registrations (15 cars in the '62-'65 category, 17 in the '66-'67, 18 in the '68-'72 group and 11 in the '73-'79 group) so it took time to decide the best way to configure (2 cars in 3 parking spots) the parking for the show and to accommodate trailers (Jerry will try to contact Worley to get permission to utilize their parking lot if necessary). It was decided Dale's trailer will be for registration and storage and located at the entrance to the show. To the west of this, the sound equipment will need to utilize the electricity. Between these 2 areas will be the spot for members to put any Nova items that you want to get rid of (be sure each part/pieces have the price, your name and phone number-please provide a list of your items with your bottom dollar amount for registration to keep track on). The registration people will handle the transaction for you. A table will also be set up in this area to sell water & pop. A car washing area is located in the NW corner of the show and Jerry will bring a 200' hose for car washing (push broom to first clean the area) and Bill will bring the cleaning supplies for our guests to utilize.

Swap meet will be located in the grassy area on the south & west sides of the show.

Trailer parking will be on the south end with a shade tent for our guests and a grassy area for pictures.

HNR plastic cups will be sold for \$2.00. Pop and water will be \$1.00 each.

Bring any/all of the raffle/goodie bag items you have gotten. Some of the donations we have received will be put onto a table for a silent auction (ie: '68 dash bezel) so the donation would go to people that could utilize it.

Our **Heartland Nova Reunion debriefing meeting** is set up for **4:00** (after the show) at **Godfather's** in Cedar Rapids to discuss results of car show.

Next meeting is scheduled for August 28th at Donahue....not real sure what time, yet.
