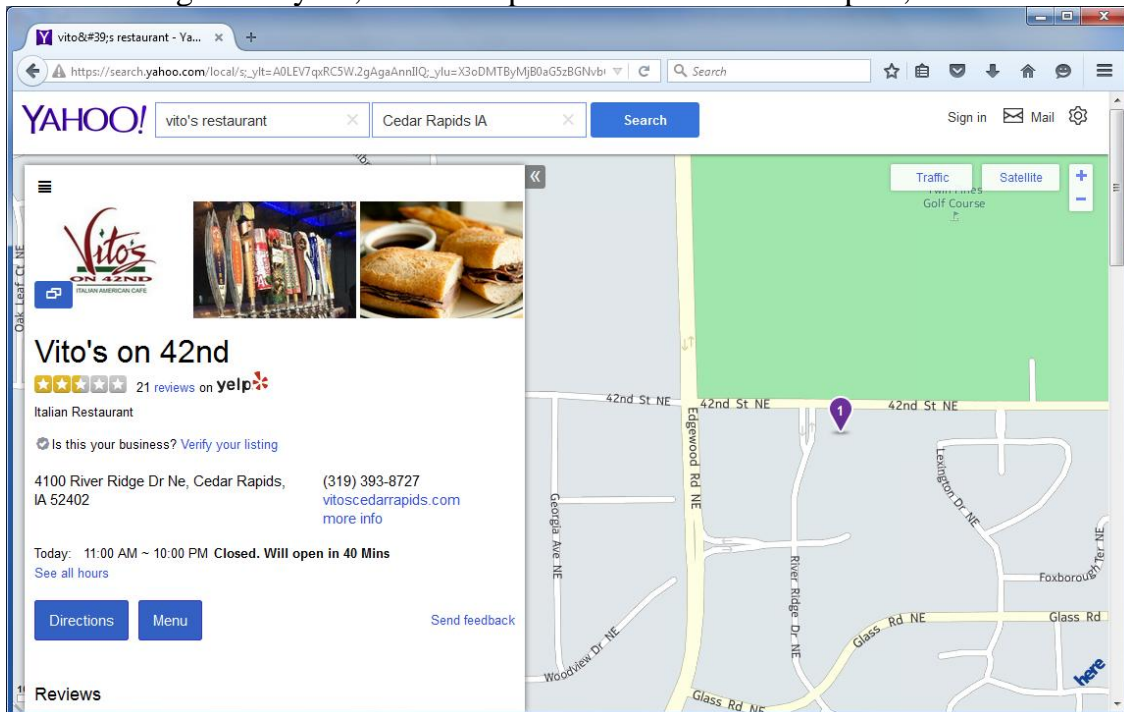

We can sell pop and water but we cannot sell food. The Isle is going to provide the hog and utensils for the hog roast. The room rates and number of rooms are being negotiated by Dale. The hotel is being very accommodating. They will provide coupons etc during our stay. Dale is also looking into security for the show. We will probably have security Thursday and Friday night from 10-6 pm.

The club is still waiting for the T-shirt design. Kevin will send out the image when he gets it. Kevin has called the company twice. He will call again so we can get things ready for the show.
